ORAL ORDER

2 24-09-2020 Heard the parties through the virtual court proceeding.

Since physical court proceeding is not functioning due
to present Pandemic Covid-19, the matter is listed with defect.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defect within three weeks of normal functioning of
the court after the lockdown, failing which the office is directed
to place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Chandan
P.S. Case No. 42 of 2020 registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 30(a)(g), 32(2) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise
Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is
no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner
rather 312.750 liters of foreign liquor has been recovered from
the Car bearing Registration No.WB02E 1458. He further



submits that the petitioner is the driver of the said Car. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in jail custody since 06.03.2020 and petitioner has got no any criminal antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the bail petition.

Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand)) in the CM Relief Fund, bearing Account No.2065104000002257, IFSC Code: IBKL0002065, Bank – IDBI, Branch – Kidwaipuri, Patna.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (twenty five thousand) only with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge 2nd, Banka in connection with Chandan P.S. Case No. 42 of 2020.

The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned Court below on showing receipt of deposit of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand)) in the CM Relief Fund.
