From perusal of report of the 1st Additional Sessions
Judge cum Special Judge, Vaishali dated 3.10.2020, kept at Flag
R, it appears that in Sessions Trial No. 185/2018 (Raghopur
Police Station Case No. 4 of 2015) out of 8 prosecution
witnesses, 5 witnesses were examined and summons and
warrants have been issued for ensuring presence of rest
witnesses and the next date in this case is 6.10.2020.
