2 17-09-2020 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the

petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Excise
Case No. 86 of 2020/GR No. 85 of 2020 for the offences under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is an old man aged about 65 years and he has no
criminal antecedent and there is allegation that he was involved
in trade of liquor. In the instant case total 19.200 litres of foreign
liquor was seized which was kept under staircase of the house of
the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 05.03.2020.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is an old man
aged about 65 years, he has no criminal antecedent and he is in



custody since 05.03.2020, the Court is inclined to grant bail to him. The petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge 2-cum-Special Judge Excise, Samastipur in connection with Excise Case No. 86 of 2020/GR No. 85 of 2020.
