2 22-09-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State through Video Conferencing.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code and section 30a of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Total 1134 liters of foreign liquor was recovered from a pick up van and a motorcycle, petitioner was arrested while other accused persons managed to escape.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and he has nothing to do with the alleged recovery. He is not the owner of the pick up van. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 4.6.2020.

Considering the facts of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge II cum Special Judge, Excise Act Vaishali at Hajipur in Sadar Police



Station Case No. 335 of 2020 on the following conditions:-

(1) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his/her absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.
