learned Additional P.P. through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks bail in Bangara P.S. Case No.66
of 2020, registered under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian
Penal Code and under Sections 30(a) and 41(1) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

House of the petitioner was raised and from his house
55 litres of country made liquor was recovered. It appears that
the learned counsel for the petitioner has not properly drafted
the bail petition. However, the petitioner has remained in jail for
about three months for recovery of 55 litres of country made
liquor from his house.
