The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Sadar Police Station Case No. 219 of 2020, registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 25(1-b)a/26/35 of the Arms
Act.

The prosecution story, as per the First Information
Report, is that the police, on the basis of the secret information
that one accused of Sadar Police Station Case No. 218 of 2020,
having beard as per video clipping, namely Subhash Thakur @
Munna Thakur (petitioner) is at his house and he has looted
cash, motorcycle and arms used in a bank dacoity, proceeded



towards the house of the petitioner and recovered one pistol along with four cartridges from his waist, looted cash and motorcycle in connection with Sadar Police Station Case No. 218 of 2020.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence in the manner alleged and on the basis of the present case, he has been remanded in Sadar Police Station Case No. 218 of 2020. He further submits that apart from these two cases, the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

After having heard learned Counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the materials on record, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

This application is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after six months from today, if the trial does not show any progress.
