ORAL ORDER

2 15-09-2020 The short relief, which the petitioner is seeking in the present writ application, is to direct respondent no. 5 to make payment of statutory subsistence allowance, which he is entitled to during the period of his suspension.

Considering the nature of relief, which the petitioner is seeking, this application is disposed of with an observation that if the petitioner approaches the respondent authorities raising his claim regarding payment of subsistence allowance,



the same shall be considered and disposed of within a period of four weeks thereafter.

It is directed that defects in the application pointed out by the Registry must be removed within two months from today.

Since there is a lockdown, the Court has considered it appropriate to adopt following procedure for communication of the present order:-

(i) The order, which has been dictated during the course of the proceedings of virtual Court, shall be communicated to me on my e-mail I.D. by the Secretary.
