2      17-09-2020                      The petitioner has been transferred from Camp Office of the Chief Engineer, Flood Control, Water Resources Department, Katihar to the office of Chief Engineer, Irrigation, Aurangabad. It appears that he has filed a representation before the Secretary, Water Resources Department, Government of Bihar expressing difficulties which he is going to face if the order of transfer is given effect to in view of his mother's ailment and posting of his wife in a school nearer to Katihar.

Considering the grievance, which the petitioner has raised in the present writ application, it is disposed of with a



direction that let the petitioner's representation, a copy of which has been brought on record by way of Annexure-6 to this application, be considered and disposed of within two weeks from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order.

It is directed that defects in the application pointed out by the Registry must be removed within two months from today.
