2 09-11-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner is in custody in connection with Islampur
P.S.Case No.643 of 2019 for the offence under Sections 304(B)
and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner is '*Dewar*' of the deceased. Petitioner is in custody
since 17.01.2020.

Considering the fact that petitioner is '*Dewar*' and he
has remained in custody since 17.01.2020, the Court is inclined
to grant bail to the petitioner named above on furnishing bail
bond of Rs.25,000/- (twenty five thousand) with two sureties of
the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial
Magistrate, Hilsa, District- Nalanda in connection with



Islampur P.S.Case No.643 of 2019 with condition that the petitioner shall extend full cooperation in early disposal of the trial and in the event he adopts delaying tactics, the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
