ORAL ORDER

4 11-11-2020 The matter has been heard *via* video conferencing due to circumstances prevailing on account of the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. Heard Mr. N K Agarwal, learned senior counsel along Mr. Manoj Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Uday Chand Prasad, learned Additional Public Prosecutor (hereinafter referred to as the ‘APP’) for the State.
