2 09-11-2020 This matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing.

Let the defects be removed within two weeks after opening of the physical court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 302/120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Eight FIR named accused persons including the petitioner and 5-6 unknown surrounded the informant and his brother and on the order of this petitioner co-accused Niraj Kumar Singh caused fire-arm injury to the brother of the informant.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 29.04.2020. Investigation of the case is already complete. Petitioner is victim of false implication due to village politics.

Considering the nature of allegation against the petitioner and completion of investigation as well as there is no material to substantiate that the petitioner is going to tamper with the evidence, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Nabinagar P.S. Case No.83 of 2020, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
