taken up by way of Virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading ‘For
Orders’ under the orders of Hon’ble the Chief Justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove the defects, as pointed out by the Office, within a period
of four weeks from the date of restoration of normalcy.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 147, 149, 353, 307 of the Indian Penal
Code , 25(1-b)a, 26, 27, 35 of the Arms Act and 13, 15, 16, 17,
18 and 20 of UAP Act.

The prosecution case in short is that the accused
persons, variously armed, formed an unlawful assembly and



were planning to explode I.E.D. blast and as soon as the police party reached, the accused persons started fleeing away but were apprehended.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 30.04.2019 and has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been submitted in the present case. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No specific overt act is alleged against the petitioner. Other co-accused has been granted bail vide Annexure-2 series to the present application.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Muzaffarpur in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 181/19.
