2. The petitioner has filed the present application under Sections 439 and 440 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail in connection with Town P.S. Case No. 151 of 2020 registered under Sections 30(a) and 41(i)(ii) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

3. Considering the nature of the offence and the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner that he was not arrested at the spot from where 45 liters of illicit liquor kept in three gallon was recovered and was arrested during investigation on 30.07.2020, he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd
