4 07-12-2020 Heard Mr. Manoj Kumar, learned counsel appearing
on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Mukeshwar Dayal, learned
Additional Public Prosecutor, for the State of Bihar.

This application for grant of regular bail arises out of
Hajipur Nagar P.S. Case No. 273 of 2020, registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 20, 22, 23, 24, 27, 27(A) and
29 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

Allegedly, from the petitioner's possession 750 gms.
of charas was recovered by the police.

In my opinion, the petitioner does not deserve regular
bail for the present taking into account the seriousness of the
offence.



This application is accordingly rejected.

It is directed that the defect(s) in the application, pointed out by the Registry, must be removed within two months.
