8 25-11-2020 This application has been filed for initiation of contempt proceeding against the opposite parties who are knowingly deliberately and intentionally violating the order dated 27.11.2017 passed by this Court in CWJC No. 15965 of 2017 along with analogous writ applications including CWJC No. 16139 of 2017.



In view of the change in the situation with regard to the position in law, inasmuch as the fact that the rules in question stands repealed and substituted by subsequent law, we are not inclined to entertain this petition.

It is also brought to our notice that similar petitions already stands disposed of by this Court. Today, most of the learned counsels have withdrawn the writ petitions which were listed along with the batch of this petition.

As such, we dispose of the present petition reserving liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition on the same and subsequent cause of action, if the need so arises.
