2. The petitioner has filed the present

application under Sections 439 and 440 of the Code of Criminal

Procedure for grant of bail in connection with Riga P.S. Case

No. 108 of 2020 registered under Section 414 of the Indian

Penal Code.

3. Considering the nature of the offence,

allegations made in the FIR, submissions advanced at the Bar

especially the period of over seven months undergone by the

petitioner in custody, the petitioner is directed to be released on



bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-1st Class, Sitamarhi in connection with Riga P.S. Case No. 108 of 2020.
