2. The petitioners have filed the present application under Sections 439 and 440 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail in connection with Dandari P.S. Case No. 49 of 2020 registered under Sections 25(1-B)(a), 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. Considering that for the alleged recovery of one country-made loaded pistol from each of the petitioners, they have remained in custody for over seven months, they are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-V, Begusarai in connection with Dandari P.S. Case No.49 of 2020.



4. Since the court proceedings are being conducted through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-
