ORAL ORDER

2 23-12-2020 Due to COVID-19 Pandemic, the matter is being taken up by
way of virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading “For Orders”
under the orders of Hon’ble the Chief Justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the
defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of four weeks
after restoration of normalcy.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for
the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case for the offence registered
under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 307, 302/323 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Allegedly, around 17 persons have been named in the FIR who
are said to have surrounded the deceased whereupon one other co-
accused person assaulted him by means of an axe leading to his
death.



It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 18-06-2020. Charge sheet/Prosecution report in this case has already been submitted. No specific injury is attributed against the petitioner. The allegation of assault is alleged against the co-accused Shivdani Ram. The other co-accuseds with similar allegation have been granted bail by coordinate benches of this court vide orders dated 09-12-2019 & 28-02-2020 passed in Cr. Misc. Nos. 80489 of 2019 and 11061 of 2020.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Sahebpur Kamal P.S. Case No. 79 of 2019.
