taken up by way of Virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading ‘For  
Orders’ under the orders of Hon’ble the Chief Justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to  
remove the defects, as pointed out by the Office, within a period  
of four weeks from the date of restoration of normalcy.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned  
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the  
offences under Sections 414, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and  
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Prosecution case, in short, is that 459 liters wine is  
recovered from poultry farm.



It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 25.7.2020 and has got no criminal antecedent. Charge-sheet/prosecution report has been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is alleged that 459 liters wine is recovered from the poultry farm of Sanjeet Sahni. The petitioner has got no concern with the alleged occurrence. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge -II-cum- Special Judge, Excise Act, Samastipur in connection with Computer Registration (Special Case) No. 698/2020 arising out of Tajpur Halai P.S. Case No. 279/2020.
