2. The petitioner has filed the present

application under Sections 439 and 440 of the Code of Criminal

Procedure for grant of bail in connection with Forbesganj

(Simraha) P.S. Case No.951 of 2019 registered under Sections

392, 397, 398 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Considering the nature of the offence, the

allegations made in the first information report, the fact that the

petitioner is not named in the FIR, the plea that after arrest he

has not been put on test identification parade and the period of

about six months undergone by him in custody, he is directed to



be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Forbesganj (Simraha) P.S. Case No.951 of 2019.

4. Since the court proceedings are being conducted through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-
