2 08-12-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Mahila P.S. Case No. 7 of 2020 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 323, 341, 504, 354-B of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 7 and 8 of the POCSO Act.

Considering that the petitioner is the own uncle of
the alleged victim and has got no criminal antecedent as also
inordinate delay of nine days in institution of the FIR relating to
alleged attempt to commit rape upon his minor niece, the
petitioner, who is in custody since 14.06.2020, is directed to be
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees
ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the
satisfaction of learned Special Judge POCSO Act-cum-
