counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Shikarpur P.S. Case No. 432 of 2018 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 302 read with 34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Considering that no overt act is alleged in the first
information report against the petitioner and the direct and
specific allegation of giving fatal blow over the head of the
deceased is attributed to co-accused Anwat Manjhi, the
petitioner, who is in custody since 23.11.2018 and as stated in
paragraph-3 of the application that he has no criminal
antecedent, he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing
bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Shikarpur P.S. Case No. 432 of 2018.

Since the court proceedings are being conducted through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-
