ORAL ORDER

3 21-12-2020 Heard Mr. Shakti Suman Kumar, learned counsel
appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Binod Kumar,
learned Additional Public Prosecutor, for the State of Bihar.

This application for grant of regular bail arises out of
Amnour P.S. Case No. 97 of 2017, registered for the offence
punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is the case of the prosecution, as disclosed in the
written report of the informant, that four miscreants had
snatched his motorcycle on the point of country made pistol.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
person, who disclosed the petitioner's name in his confessional
statement before the police, has been allowed bail by an order
dated 20.07.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 44059 of 2018. It has
been further submitted that some other co accused persons have
been allowed bail by this Court, whose names had also



transpired on the basis of confessional statement of the same accused, who have been allowed regular bail by this Court by an order dated 04.05.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 20427 of 2018.

Considering the circumstance that co-accused has been allowed regular bail, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Saran at Chapra, in Amnour P.S. Case No. 97 of 2017.

It is directed that the defect(s) in the application, pointed out by the Registry, must be removed within two months.
