2. The petitioner has filed the present

application under Sections 439 and 440 of the Code of Criminal

Procedure for grant of bail in connection with Tarari P.S. Case

No.75 of 2020 registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar

Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

3. Considering the nature of the offence, the

alleged recovery of about 80 litres illicit liquor by the police

party for which five persons including the petitioner have been

named in the first information report and the period of over six

months undergone by the petitioner in custody, he is directed to



be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 4th Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Excise Case No.671 of 2020 arising out of Tarari P.S. Case No.75 of 2020.

4. Since the court proceedings are being conducted through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-

- (i) The order, which has been dictated during the course of proceeding of the virtual court, shall be communicated to me on my e-mail by the Senior Secretary.
