ORAL ORDER

4 23-12-2020 Heard Ms. Pratima Kumari, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mrs. Veena Kumari Jaiswal, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, for the State of Bihar.

This application for grant of regular bail arises out of Mahua P.S. Case No. 707 of 2019, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a), 32(ii), 34(ii), 38(ii) and 41(i) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2018.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that similarly circumstanced co-accused Mukesh Kumar and Sumit have been allowed regular bail by this Court by orders dated 13.05.2020 and 15.12.2020. On perusal of the said orders, which have been provided by learned counsel for the petitioner to the Court Master, in my opinion, there is nothing to distinguish petitioner's case from the case of those, who have been allowed bail.



Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise Court, Vaishali at Hajipur, in Mahua P.S. Case No. 707 of 2019.

It is directed that the defect(s) in the application, pointed out by the Registry, must be removed within two months.
