appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Bisheshwar Ram,
learned Additional Public Prosecutor, for the State of Bihar.

This application for grant of regular bail arises out of
Mashrak P.S. Case No. 96 of 2020, registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 188, 504, 506/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner states that this application has become infructuous as
the petitioner has been allowed regular bail by the Court below
under Section 167 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This application is accordingly dismissed as
withdrawn.
