Motorcycle bearing Registration No. BR11V-8326 which has been
seized in connection with Araria (R.S.) P.S. Case No. 188 of 2017,
for the offences punishable under Sections 30(A), 36 and 38 of
the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner invites our attention
to the order dated 18th January, 2020 passed in CWJC No. 3245 of

Ors. and prays for disposal in terms thereof.

As such, as prayed for, on mutually agreed terms, we dispose of the present petition in terms of the order dated 18th January, 2020 passed in CWJC No. 3245 of 2017 titled as Manish Kumar Chaudhary Vs.
