Initially the writ application was filed for release of Scorio vehicle bearing registration no. BR-05S-0498, which has been seized in connection with Balthar P.S. Case No. 85 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise and Prohibition Act, 2016 as amended by Act 8 of 2018 (hereinafter referred to as the Act) but since final order dated 27.1.2020 has been passed in Confiscation Case No. 581 of 2018-19, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks



permission to withdraw the writ application enabling the petitioner to prefer appeal.

This writ application is, accordingly, disposed of as withdrawn.

It is made clear that if the vehicle in question has not been auction , it shall not be put to auction till the disposal of the stay petition by the appellate authority if such appeal is filed.
