Shri Lalit Kishore, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the Bihar School Examination Board and Shri Yugal Kishore, learned senior counsel appearing for the private respondents state that the present appeal has become infructuous, inasmuch as the Committee, subject matter of the writ petition, constituted in the year 2014, stands substituted.

At this stage, learned counsel for the appellant states



that the writ-petitioner/appellant shall be content if a direction is issued to expedite the hearing of the appeal preferred by the petitioner.

Well, none can have any objection to the same. As such, the appeal stands disposed of with a direction to the Appellate Authority, constituted under the provisions of Bihar School Examination Board Affiliation Rules, to hear and decide the appeal inter se the parties on merits, in accordance with law.

We hope and expect that the said authority shall decide the appeal within a period of six months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
