Petitioner has filed this writ petition against the order dated 09.09.2020 passed in Excise (Appeal) Case No. 81 of 2020 dismissing the appeal and affirming the order of confiscation dated 07.02.2020 passed by the Collector, Banka, in Confiscation (Excise Prohibition) Case No. 465 of 2019-20.

Petitioner has approached this Court in its writ jurisdiction without availing the statutory remedy of revision against the order passed by the Appellate Authority, as such
