The petitioner prays for release the Vehicle (Motor Cycle-
Apache) bearing Registration No. BR-31 AE-6080 which has been
seized in connection with PR. No. 183 of 2019 for the offences
punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner invites our attention to
