The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection
with Rajoun P.S. Case No.178 of 2018 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504 and

institution of the first information report, the petitioners are
directed to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or
