The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Malsalami P.S. Case No. 158 of 2016 for the offence under
Sections 20, 22, 25, 25(a) of the N.D.P.S. Act.

Considering the material available on record, the
Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly,
the prayer for grant of bail of the petitioner is rejected.
