The petitioner has prayed for the following relief:-

“The present writ application is being filed for seeing direction upon the Respondents concerned to release the vehicle (Honda Shine Motorcycle) bearing Regd. No. BR01E B0277, Chassis No. MEAJC65BMJ7145747 and Engine No. JC65E72419383 in favour of the petitioner which has been seized in



connection with Special Case No. 3648/2019 arising out of S.K.Puri P. S. Case No. 120/2019 u/s 279, 341 I.P.C. and 37(b)(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016. Further for any other relief or reliefs for which petitioner is found entitled to in the facts and circumstances of the case.”
