The petitioner prays for release of Tempo (Auto Piaggio Ape) bearing Registration No. BR-01pd 7912, seized in connection with Alamganj P.S. Case No. 517/2018, registered for the offence under Section 13A of Bihar Prohibition & Excise (Amendment) Act, 2016, corresponding to Spl. Case No. 8502/2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner invites our attention to the order dated 18th January, 2020 passed in CWJC No. 3245 of 2017 titled as Manish Kumar Chaudhary Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors. and prays for disposal in terms thereof.
