On the other hand he is paying the amount in the Nazarat but not regularly and trying to pay the amount and whatever dues are



there, he will clear the same within a period of one month from receipt of order.

In view of the above, I am not inclined to interfere with the order. However, if O.P.no.2 fails to comply the above observation, the learned court below will cancel the bail bond of O.P.no.2

Accordingly, this application is disposed of with above observation.
