Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and learned counsel
for the informant.

The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with
Banshi P.S. Case No.70 of 2017 registered under Sections 304-
B, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the serious
nature of allegation against the petitioner and others that they
killed the daughter of the informant for non-fulfillment of
demand of dowry and hurriedly disposed of her body in order to
conceal the evidence, I am not inclined to grant him pre-arrest
bail. The application is rejected.

Since the court proceedings are being conducted
through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been



restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-
