7 24-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under section 498(A) of the IPC and
section 3/4 of D.P. Act.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that due to non-
fulfillment of demand of dowry, petitioner started torturing and
assaulting the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, while refuting
the allegation, submits that petitioner has falsely been
implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that the
allegation of demand of dowry is not against the petitioner.
Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.



In view of specific allegation of demand of dowry and torturing the complainant against the petitioner, the prayer for bail is refused.

Accordingly, this application for bail is rejected.
