- “(i) For issuance of a writ in the nature of a direction to the respondent no. 3 to institute a criminal case under the provision of Prevention of Corruption Act against the respondent no. 5.
- (ii) For issuance of a writ in the nature of a direction to respondent no. 1 to give direction to the respondent no. 3 either institute the case or enquire the matter of own level against the respondent no. 5 on the basis of allegation as contained in Annexure-7 to the petition.”



From the counter affidavit dated 09.01.2020 filed on behalf of the respondents no. 3 and 4, it is apparent that the State has taken action against the erring official who stands suspended and disciplinary proceedings initiated.

In view of the same, we find the present petition to have become infructuous. As such, the instant petition stands dismissed.
