5 04-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties. Despite of
Service, no one appears for the opposite party.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Complaint
Case No.2124/2018 registered for the offence under Section
498A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of DP Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is ready to keep his wife with full honour and dignity.
It is further submitted that it is the O.P. No.2 who has filed a
divorce case no. 592/2018 for dissolution of marriage. Petitioner
has no criminal antecedent.
