Learned counsels are appearing and making
submissions from their residence. The Court Master and
Secretary are also part of this virtual Court proceedings with the
aid of audio visual technology.

Heard Mr Satya Prakash Parasar, learned counsel for
the petitioner as well as Mr Md Nadim Seraj, learned GP V for
the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on
certain allegations regarding obtaining the employment by



misrepresenting her height, petitioner has been proceeded against in Departmental Proceeding No 59 of 2018. The submission is that no subsistence allowance is being paid.

Short submission is that petitioner's claim, in the said background for subsistence allowance made before the Superintendent of Police, Bagaha (West Champaran), be disposed of.

Annexure 4 is a copy of the said claim made by the petitioner. The same does not bear any receiving. It is not possible to conclude that the same has been received in the office of the Superintendent of Police, Bagaha.

The petitioner should, therefore, make representation afresh to facilitate consideration.

If representation is made within four weeks, the Superintendent of Police, Bagaha (Respondent No 4) be obliged to take final decision thereon and pay the amount found due and admissible to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of.
