2      06-01-2020                      The petition filed on 19.07.2018 is listed for hearing  
for the first time today before the Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned  
counsel for the respondents.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief:



“ For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus, commanding upon the respondents no. 1 to 4 to stop operation of Cow-Shed (Khatal) in Municipal Area; specially the Khatal of Shri Anat Rai, s/o Late Saudagar Rai, Mohalla- Kathpul, near the house of ex ward councillor Shri Shyam Babu Yadav, Mandiri, Distt- Patna. Who has kept 10 cows. These cows spread dung in whole locality that is harmful and injurious to health. Some times these animals attack upon human being and injure them. In Municipal area to keep cow is illegal and wrong. Some times they stray and attack upon men or women. This is violation of article 47.”

After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner shall be content if a direction is issued to the concerned respondents to consider and decide the representation, which the petitioner shall be making afresh within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the State states that upon receipt of such request, if any, the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law, expeditiously and positively within a period of three months from the date of receipt thereof.

Equally, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to take recourse to such alternative remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.

We are hopeful that as and when petitioner takes



recourse to such remedies, as are otherwise available in law,  
before the appropriate forum, the same shall be dealt with, in  
accordance with law and with reasonable dispatch.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
