ORAL ORDER

6 01-09-2020 A counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of Patna Municipal Corporation. From the averments made in paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 of the counter affidavit it appears that grievance of the petitioner in relation to payment of retiral dues, consequent upon the death of her late husband in harness, has been substantially redressed. Family pension and monthly family pension has been authorised. The difference of arrears of salary arising out of grant of ACP has also been paid.

Considering the above, this application is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to approach the competent authority if she is not satisfied with the



computation of the amount of family pension and other entitlements.

It is directed that defects in the application pointed out by the Registry must be removed within two months from today.

Since there is a lockdown, the Court has considered it appropriate to adopt following procedure for communication of the present order:-
