2. The petitioners have invoked extraordinary jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure against the order dated 12.03.2019, whereby the Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate-X, Gopalganj took the cognizance under Sections 341, 323, 324, 308, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code against the petitioners, who



were not sent up for trial along with accused Navin Yadav and Sadhu Yadav against whom, after investigation, the Chargesheet was submitted.

3. On going through the impugned order, I do not find any illegality amounting to abuse of process of Court for interference in extraordinary jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.
