ORAL ORDER

5 24-02-2020 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since under some wrong advise the petitioner has filed this writ application challenging the order of confiscation, he may be permitted to withdraw this writ application with liberty to seek his remedy of statutory appeal before the appropriate forum.
