3 04-03-2020 The present petition has been filed for restoring a writ petition bearing CWJC no. 11656 of 2019, which has stood dismissed for default on account of non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 18.06.2019.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the requisites etc. have already been filed for the purposes of



issuance of notice to respondents no. 3, 8 and 9, hence the order of this Court dated 18.06.2019 has already stood complied with, however there has been a delay of 03 days resulting in dismissal of the writ petition for default.
