ORAL ORDER

2 24-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 1561C of 2017, registered under Sections 406, 323, 379, 354 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case with ulterior motive and village politics. He further submits that there is complaint case instead of lodging an FIR against the petitioners. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent.



Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case, let the above-named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vth, Araria in connection with Complaint Case No. 1561C of 2017 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
