3 09-01-2020 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises

out of Rampur P.S. Case No. 144 of 2018, disclosing offences

under Sections 457/380 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case is that while the informant has gone
out, there was theft in his house and he suspects the hands of
petitioner, who is a neighbour.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that he has no criminal antecedent and has falsely been
implicated in this case only on the basis of suspicion and except
that there is nothing against the petitioner.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the submission,
as above, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above



named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Rampur P.S. Case No. 144 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
