2 16-01-2020 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Motihari Muffasil P. S. Case No. 202 of 2019 disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 354B and 34 of IPC.

As per prosecution case petitioners assaulted the informant and her husband and also torn her blouse.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that the injury is simple in nature, which will appear from Annexure 2 and allegation of tearing her blouse is ornamental in nature, just to make the case serious.

Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Motihari Muffasil P. S. Case No. 202 of 2019.
