ORAL ORDER

6 01-09-2020 In compliance of the order dated 01.07.2020, the Director General of Police, Bihar has filed a counter affidavit. On perusal of the paragraph 9 of the said counter affidavit, it appears that no objection certificate has now been issued to the petitioner for payment of his pension. The petitioner's grievance has thus been substantially redressed.

This writ application has accordingly become infructuous and stands disposed of.



It is, however, observed that if, according to the petitioner, he has not been paid his entitlements as per his claim, he shall be at liberty to approach the competent authority for redressal of his grievances.

It is directed that defects in the application pointed out by the Registry must be removed within two months from today.

Since there is a lockdown, the Court has considered it appropriate to adopt following procedure for communication of the present order:-
